## Guidelines for success:

## **Procedures for Enhanced Reading:**

## Tardy to Class:

You will be counted tardy for class if you are not in your seat with your materials for class when the bell rings. You will receive a tardy if you do not come prepared to class and are asked to go to your locker to get your materials.

### **Classroom Library:**

The library in the classroom is for your use. To check out a book please fill out the checkout form on the closet door. When finished with a book put it in the book turn in box and cross your name off the list.

### **Classroom Behavior:**

You will be expected to follow school rules. If a problem does arise, you will be given a warning. If the behavior continues, you may be assigned a detention and/or will be removed from class. After class or after school will be the best time to discuss concerns you have. You will also loose 3 participation points for the day.

### **Detentions:**

You are expected to serve detentions after school from 3:20-3:50. You must serve your detention within the week or it is turned over to administration for further consequences.

## **Restroom Use:**
